Thursday- CGP books checked and new pages given out in class

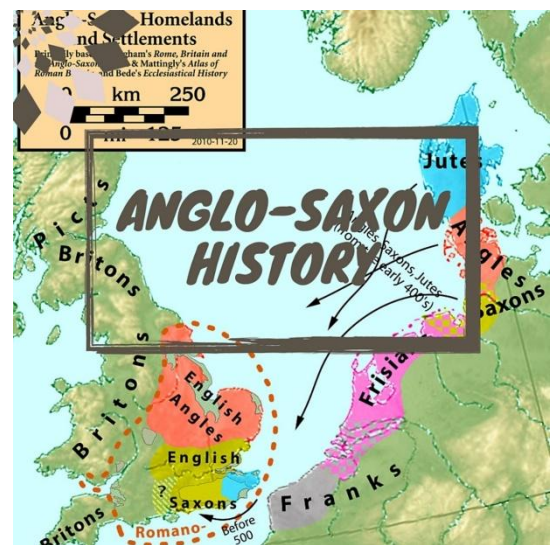
Friday- Reading records checked
