

Reminders

Rolling start to the day

8.35am - Pedestrian gate will open:

- EYFS and Key Stage 1 children and parents are welcome to come and wait on the Key Stage 1 playground. Please follow the path around the EYFS outdoor area.
- Key Stage 2 children and parents are welcome to come and wait on the Key Stage 2 playground.
- A member of the Senior Leadership Team will be available on the Key Stage 2 playground, should you need them.

8.45am - The bell will go:

- EYFS to enter the school via the EYFS Classroom door
- Key Stage 1 to enter the school via the Key Stage 1 door
- Year 3 to enter the school via the Year 3 Cloakroom door
- Years 4,5 and 6 to enter the school via the Key Stage 2 ramp door

Doors will shut at 8.55am. Therefore, the children have a 10 minute rolling window to enter school.

One-way system

The one-way system will no longer be in use. Families will enter and exit the school site via the pedestrian gate and pathway.

End to the school day

To ensure all children have their statutory time in school, the end of the day will be 3.15pm for all classes. Please can we ask that the youngest children are collected first.

- EYFS to be collected from the EYFS Classroom door
- Key Stage 1 to be collected from the Key Stage 1 door
- Year 3 to be collected from the Year 3 Cloakroom door
- Years 4 and 5 to be dismissed from the steps
- Year 6 to be dismissed from the ramp

If someone different is picking up your child, please inform the school office in advance.

Absence

If your child is unable to attend school, please inform the school office no later than 9am with the reason for the absence.

Wraparound

The timings for Wraparound remains the same:

- Breakfast Club - Session 1 will remain from 7.30am to 8am and Session 2 begins from 8.00am to 8.50am. All children will go to class at 8.50am.
- After School Club - Session 1 starts from 3.15pm and ends at 4.20pm. Session 2 remains from 4.20pm to 5.30pm.
- Booking will be moving across to Bromcom, following information from the school office.
- Only families who have registered with the Wraparound provision are able to book. Please see the school office if you wish to register your child.

Extra-Curricular Clubs

School lunches

If you have not ordered a school lunch from Kingswood, please ensure that you send a packed lunch with your child. Whether your child has a school lunch or a packed lunch, please send in a drink bottle, as it is important for us to keep the children hydrated.

Uniform

Please ensure that your child is adhering to the school uniform policy. After careful consideration, the children are invited to continue to attend school wearing their school PE kit on PE days. Teachers will inform you on Tapestry/Dojo of the day. Children should not be wearing branded items, leggings, or different coloured items.
